Please note: Both leagues will initially be divided into three levels of play based on registration. During the first four weeks of play there will be no challenges to move up (or down) as the coordinators will be reviewing team records and observing team play during this time. After the first four weeks of play, movement between the levels of play may be made at the discretion of the coordinators and win/loss record will be an important consideration. In addition, the coordinators will have the discretion to alter the number of levels based on team play. Every attempt will be made to place teams in the division they have requested although teams should keep in mind that some shifting may be necessary in order to initially round out the levels of play.

Team information for O.C. League Volleyball

To register your team you'll need:

- A completed copy of this form, listing **at least 4 players for Monday and 6 players for Tuesday**. Players will be allowed to play on both nights. Monday night rosters will require at least one male and one female.
- To register your team on the first night of signups, **all players** listed on the team roster must have valid 2008-09 Membership and Applicant cards. Dues should be paid directly to the Membership/Applicant Committee. Team members can pay dues individually or team captains can pay dues [and provide necessary member/applicant information] at the April 10th meeting or on team signup nights.
- Although not required, teams with one or more players on the roster that are current 2008-2009 O.C. Ski Club members will be given priority on the first night of signup.
- A team registration fee of \$150. **Checks for team registration and club dues should be made payable to the "O.C. Ski Club" (NOTE: Only one check will be accepted for the team fee, multiple checks (if needed) for club dues).**
- At least one team member/representative to fulfill the team's setup day requirement on Saturday, May 10th. That person **must sign in by 11:00am**, actively participate in setup tasks as directed and sign out when released; failure to fulfill this requirement may result in your team losing its spot to a team on the waiting list, or in other penalties. Setup usually takes several hours. If interested, we will play when setup is completed.

Registration will be held:

- At the **P.C.C.** on **April 17th from 7:00-9:00 pm** and on **April 24th from 7:00-8:00pm**. Teams with at least one O.C. member on the roster at signup will be given priority. Teams without an O.C. member can still register the first night but their registration forms will be given secondary consideration. There is no priority given to teams registering the second night. If any spots are left, signups will be accepted on setup day.

Please note:

- Team registrations will be accepted on a "first come/first served" basis.
- There will be a captain's meeting on the first night of play; all players are welcome, but the team captain (or a representative) must attend. Copies of the league rules will be distributed, and we'll discuss team responsibilities, game procedures and other details of the playing season. Team referees should also attend this meeting; at least two players per team must have sufficient knowledge of the rules to properly officiate league matches. USA Volleyball rules will be in effect for both nights of play.
- League play begins on May 12th for co-ed 4's and on May 13th for 6's.
- There will be no challenges to move between levels the first four weeks of play. Please endeavor to place your team in the proper level. If a team is incorrectly placed, the coordinators may move it to another level if there is a corresponding team in that level which should also be moved.
- Mon Co-ed 4's: For official league play, a team of four must have one male and one female on the court at all times. No exceptions. Teams can play with three (regardless of male/female) as long as all three are on the team roster. Teams with less than that number will forfeit and lose four wins (if the forfeiting team refs, only two wins will be lost).
- Tues 6's: A minimum of four team members (who are listed on the team roster) is necessary for official league play; teams with less than that number will forfeit that evening's games and lose four wins (if the forfeiting team refs, only two wins will be lost).
- "Subs" are not permitted in this league; everyone playing for your team must appear on the official roster.
- The P.C.C. has some ground rules in order for us to use their facility, which will be followed without exception. It is the captain's responsibility to insure that **all** team members know, understand and abide by these rules:
 - **No pets are allowed on the premises at any time.**
 - **No beer or other alcohol will be allowed to be brought in from outside sources.** The P.C.C. bar will be open for those who want alcoholic refreshments.
 - **Please leave your children at home, for their safety as well as the safety of the players.** Any children brought on-site must stay in the areas designated by the coordinators.
 - **Shoes or other appropriate footwear are recommended while on the courts.**
 - **Please park vehicles on the sides and back of the parking lot, as directed by the P.C.C.**
