That is, activities that are covered by the Club's liability insurance policy. These are informal events or activities, which may be characterized by the following:

The participants are not exclusively OC members or applicants (even for the duration of the event).

The members have not engaged into an agreement with an outfitter or organization to provide a service or contractual use of their facilities.

These are activities such as, but not limited to—hiking, bicycling, roller blading, snow shoeing, mountain biking, swimming, boating, ice climbing, tennis...

This advisement, is in no way meant to discourage our membership from continuing such activities, but is a means of defining and separating certain liabilities and accountability of risk for our Club.

Your Club's Board of Directors encourages and is excited over this type of enthusiasm and camaraderie—and is pleased to offer, as a service to our members, the Out of Control Lifeline and Web site, for posting scheduling and announcements of informal member organized activities. (This should be done with prior approval of the President and/or VP of Administration).

*If you have an interest in pursuing the possibility of having your activity/event sanctioned, please note the following:

- All participants must be members (even if only for the duration of the event/activity).
- Policies and appropriate waivers must be submitted for Board approval.
- In turn, The President must submit all necessary information to our Club's insurance carrier for their review and potential endorsement.
- The activity/event must be self-supporting (at no additional cost to our club).
